

## NOTICE OF VACANCY ON PARK HILL BOARD OF EDUCATION

Notice is hereby given that there is a vacancy on the Park Hill Board of Education. The person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office until the April 2018 election. Interested applicants must contact the Board Secretary to obtain an application packet. Applications must be received at the address below by 12:00 p.m. (Noon) on Friday, April 14, 2017. The Board is tentatively scheduled to select interviewees in Open Session at a Special Meeting at 6:00 p.m. on April 17<sup>th</sup> followed by interviews and selection of a final candidate in Open Session at a Special Meeting tentatively set for 6:00 p.m. on April 20<sup>th</sup>. It is anticipated that the final candidate will be officially appointed and sworn in at the April 27, 2017, 7:00 p.m. Regular meeting.

To qualify for this position, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a citizen of the United States of America. Mo. Const. art. VII, Section 8; Section 162.291, RSMo.
2. Be a resident taxpayer of the Park Hill School District. Section 162.291, RSMo.
3. Have resided in Missouri for a minimum of one year immediately preceding your appointment, if appointed. Mo. Const. art. VII, Section 8; Section 162.291, RSMo.
4. Be at least 24 years of age. Section 162.291, RSMo.
5. Not delinquent in the payment of any state income taxes, personal property taxes, municipal taxes or real property taxes on your place of residence as listed on this form. If an applicant is a past or present corporate officer of any fee office, that office does not be delinquent in the payment of any taxes owed the state. Section 115.306, RSMo.
6. Not have been found guilty of nor pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor under the federal laws of the United States of America or to a felony under Missouri law or an offense committed in another state that would be considered a felony in Missouri. Section 115.306, RSMo.
7. Not be registered or required to be registered as a sex offender under Section 162.014, RSMo.
8. Have filed, or the treasurer of any existing candidate committee has filed, all required campaign disclosure reports with the Missouri Ethics Commission, when applicable, for all previous elections in which I was a candidate. Section 130.071, RSMo.
