

Minutes of
Park Hill PTA District Council
General Meeting

October 16, 2014

District Council President Michael Atchison called the meeting to order at 9:34am. The following members that were present are attached and a quorum was met. Minutes from last meeting were reviewed and filed.

District Council Treasurer, Aimee Claassen, reported that the budget is in good shape. She has collected almost every PTA's dues.

Director of Communication Services, Nicole Kirby, informed us that a task force was put together to look at district revenue keeping up with district growth. She also stated that a committee of teachers were put together to review the technology given to students using less money. They presented their findings to the board. Plus the board chose to vote 'no' on Amendment 3.

President Atchison introduced speaker, Kristi May, Director for Miles of Smiles. She explained that Miles of Smiles is a free mobile dental care for students. They go into the schools of Clay and Platte counties providing their services, and each year to 350-400 students in Park Hill alone. She presented a touching video of students who have been affected by Miles of Smiles.

Bylaws committee reported that they reviewed the Park Hill District PTA bylaws and then proposed a few changes. Susan Buckles, moved "That the proposed changes should be made to the bylaws." Motion carried.

As for the Committee Reports, the clothing center reported a big number of shoppers in October, the formal dressing room has opened, and they are in need of little boys pants.

A short discussion took place about Line Creek Elementary putting together a program for teacher grants.

The meeting adjourned at 10:10am.
